RE: Scholarships Available

Attached is information on the **2010 Scholarship** programs available through the Peninsula Music Festival. I hope you will all encourage your students to take advantage of these opportunities.

**Scholarships** consist of the *Peninsula Music Festival Scholarship* and the *Summer Music Awards*.

The *Summer Music Awards* consist of **five \$100 awards** given each spring to music students who are freshmen, sophomores, or juniors. One award will be offered to students in each of the five Door County Public Schools. The purpose of the awards is to help defray the cost of music lessons or summer music camps. To be eligible, students must have demonstrated a sustained interest in music and commitment to further education in this field. **The awards are given to a student suggested by their music teacher.** We encourage all administrators to make sure that a student is recommended from your school. Please take the time to nominate a student or students from your school. You can award the \$100 to one student or split it up - \$50 to two or \$25 to four. Just e-mail the names of the students and what the money will be used for - name of camp or private instructor (musicfestival@charterinternet.com). Your decision does not have to be based on *need*. You can award the money based on desire, motivation, etc.

The *Peninsula Music Festival Scholarship* is awarded to a graduating senior each year who meets the necessary qualifications. All application information is enclosed. Please **encourage only qualified music students** to apply. This is a \$3000 college scholarship so please encourage your students who wish to study music in college to apply.
